Sir,

Sub:- State Election Commission – General Election 2015 – Free & fair election – maintenance of law and order during election – reg.

The State Election Commission proposes to conduct General Elections to the Local bodies in the State on November 2nd & 5th, 2015. Therefore, necessary steps may be taken for the conduct of free, fair and peaceful elections and to safeguard against corrupt practices of booth-capturing and intimidation and undue influence of voters.

1. Special steps shall be taken in the matter of deployment of Police Force and mixing of Police Force and mixing of Police personnel and Special Police Officers, if any engaged.
2. As regards, “lethal weapons” (ie. other than fire-arms) the public should be asked through mass publicity not to carry them during the entire period of electioneering and till a week after the results are declared. Anybody seen carrying such lethal weapons during the period should be dealt with severely and the weapons seized.

3. Thorough checking of vehicles shall be done for three days before the day of poll, on poll day and till completion of counting of votes, to ensure that no undesirable elements or arms and ammunitions are smuggled into the constituency from outside. The culprits should be apprehended and their arms and ammunitions and vehicles confiscated. Cars / vehicles should not be allowed to move in convoys of more than three vehicles.
