#### **ORDER**

Date: 20/04/2022

The State Election Commission is constituted under Articles 243 K and 243 ZA of the constitution of India for the superintendence, direction and control of the preparation of the electoral rolls for, and the conduct of all elections to the Panchayaths and Municipalities in the state. Apart from it, being a constitutional functionary, the Commission also provides internship for aspiring Law students. Considering the pandemic situation then prevailed Commission revamped the internship programme provided to law students and revised instructions were issued as per the order referred

to above.

As the situation has improved now and Government diluted the restrictions imposed due to the pandemic, the Commission has decided to issue the following revised instructions to those law students who desire for internship in Kerala State Election Commission and College Principals thereof.

- The duration of the internship programme for Law students in State Election Commission will be 10 days.
- The College Principals should furnish the list of students who desire to undergo internship in the Commission well in advance.
- The maximum number of students who can participate in a programme shall be limited to 10. Timing of the programme is 10.30 am to 4.30 pm.
- The students shall abide by the instructions of the officers of the Commission during the period of their internship in the Commission and should ensure office decorum.
- Any misbehavior or impolite action from the part of the students shall lead to the cancellation of internship of such

- students in the Commission.
- The students shall be in college uniform and keep punctuality during the internship in the Commission.
- Each student shall prepare and submit assignments on the topics assigned to him (Topics of assignments are mentioned in the Annexure-I)
- Each student shall prepare and submit essay on the topics assigned to him (Topics of essay are attached herewith as Annexure-II)
- Each student shall study the Act & Rules related to election to local bodies in the state and submit a detailed note on it.
   (Reference -'Election Guide' published by Kerala State Election Commission)
- Each student shall conduct a case study on the Judgment of the Hon' High Court relating to elections and submit a detailed report on selected judgment.( Reference Landmark Judgements on elections to local authorities in Kerala published by SEC )
- Each student shall select a book of their choice and submit a

detailed review.

- Each student shall submit the assignment and the above mentioned work on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of the internship programme.
- Commission, after evaluating the assignments and other works submitted by each student, will issue certificate of internship to the students on the last day of the internship programme.

These instructions are applicable to all pending applications for internship as well as new applications.
